Specification of Enrolment Procedure for Non-EU Foreign Students

Students must **necessarily** register on the *DELPHI system* and follow the procedure for verifying the curricular requirements for one of the master's degree courses:

- 5. <u>Chimica</u> (Classe LM-54)
- 6. Fisica (Classe LM-17)
- 7. Informatica (Classe LM-18)
- 8. Matematica Pura e Applicata (classe LM-40)
- 9. <u>Scienze e Tecnologie dei Materiali</u> (Classe LM-53)

The procedure for **non-EU students** applying for visas will be active from **12**th **June until 14**th **July**, as reported on p. 3 of the **call** for admission that can be found here:

The visa application is submitted exclusively through the Universitaly site:

https://www.universitaly.it/index.php/students/stranieri platform .

The application must be submitted by 31st July.

The University does not issue letters of admission. Once admitted, you can print the **screenshot** of the admission result on the DELPHI system.

When the application on Universitaly is validated, we will indicate that it has been admitted with reservations.

By July 31st, you must upload the final certificate of Italian language level B2 and the certificate of comparability issued by CIMEA on the Universitaly platform, to be requested at the following link: https://cimea.diplo-me.eu/torvergata/#/auth/login

The certificate must express a favorable opinion on enrolment.

These are the necessary procedures that all non-EU students must follow to come and study in Italy and at our university.

Consequently, we advise you to register as soon as possible on the Universitaly portal, to request the certificate of comparability at CIMEA and from 12th June to register on the DELPHI system for the procedure of verification of curricular requirements.
